Bourbon Selection

Canadian Club / 6, Larceny / 8, Maker's Mark / 8, Seagrams 7 / 7, Seagram VO / 6, Wild Turkey 101 / 8, Wild Turkey Rare Breed / 11, Crown Royal / 8.75, Four Roses / 9.5, Jim Black / 7.5, Jameson's / 7.5, Evan Williams / 6.5, Jim Beam / 6, Makers Mint / 8 and Angel Envy Rye / 13

Angel Envy - hints of vanilla, ripe fruit, maple syrup, toast, and bitter chocolate with a clean and lingering sweet finish and a hint of Madeira that slowly fades 13

Basil Hayden's- bourbon with a uniquely high-rye mashbill, combining the sweetness of corn with the spicy undertones of rye 8.5

Basil Hayden Toast – Light and sweet aroma with a slightly nutty undertone that pulls it together 13

Blade and Bow - subtle aroma of fresh fruit, dried apricot, ripe pear, charred oak, and warm winter spices 12

Blantons – a deep, satisfying nose of nutmeg & spices, powerful dry vanilla notes in harmony with a hint of honey amid strong caramel and corn 20

Bowman Brothers- which is carefully distilled at Abraham Bowman is adored for its caramel, pepper, gingerbread and nutty flavor notes 9

Buffalo Trace - sweet to the taste with notes of brown sugar and spice that give way to oak, toffee, dark fruit, and anise 10

Bulleit - gentle spiciness and sweet oak aromas, smooth with tones of maple, oak, and nutmeg 10.5

Colonel E. H. Taylor – Small Batch Vanilla, light tobacco, leather, and white pepper start the finish off, along with a pleasant burn that's isolated. As the finish goes on and flavors dissipate, a dry leathery flavor dusted with a slight hint of white pepper and dried apricot remains. 20

Eagle Rare - lofty, distinctive bourbon with bold, dry, oaky flavors with notes of candied almonds and very rich cocoa with a dry and lingering finish 13

Elijah Craig was a Baptist preacher who created the process for "true Kentucky bourbon." Vanilla, caramel, nut and oak pop out from the start. Sweet and light at first, these flavors slightly intensify with time in the glass. 8

Elijah Craig – Barrell Proof – A122 120.8 Proof- Caramel, lightly toasted marshmallow, light honey, vanilla dipped oak, light barrel char with a classic bourbon scents 14

Elmer T Lee – hints of peach, dried raisin, and maple candy. Followed by a burst of wood and spice akin to pre ground black pepper. 14

Four Roses – single batch – The finish is all about the oak – dry, with a black pepper spiciness. The gorgeous aftertaste lingers, with notes of candied orange peel and toffee. 9.5

Four Roses – single batch SELECT– The spice carries through to start off the finish. As it tapers off it's joined by leather, a drier oak, and sweet vanilla. These flavors gently linger, resulting in a nice medium length finish. It's a pleasant way to end the sip. 13

Henry McKenna - one of the longest aged Bottled-in-Bond whiskeys available 10

Isaac Bowman - The finish is sweet and slightly fruity from the red wine cask. So smooth, so delicious. 10

Jefferson's GRAND Select - Notes of robust flavor of Bordeaux, toasted American and French oak on the nose. Strong flavors on the palate, with hints of chocolate and fresh brewed coffee. The finish is fruity and spicy with a very pronounced wine-forward flavor that lingers on the palate. 13.5

Jefferson's Ocean – Aged at Sea Journey 20 & 24 - briny, savory taste from the barrels breathing the sea air is reminiscent of Islay Scotch 15

Jefferson's Reserve - sophisticated bourbon that has a lot of flavor up front, a lot of weight mid palate and a deep finish 12.5

Knob Creek – Single Barrel – Starts with a subtly woody richness, which blooms into a hot fruitiness as the whiskey expands to fill the middle of the mouth, evincing the high proof. The presents of strongly brewed iced tea with a large lemon wedge squeezed in. 10

Knob Creek RYE Single Barrel – Sharp, vanilla, orange, pepper spice, oak; water tamps the edges bringing more caramel and orange marmalade and thickens with the mouthfeel nicely 11

Knob Creek Single Barrel - deep and complex flavors of vanilla, nuts, and oak 10

Larceny Barrell Proof - C921 122.6 Proof Toasted pecan, cream soda, three Musketeers candy bar, molasses, browned butter, charred oak. To the palate it is black cherry, plum, touch of dark maple syrup with a vanilla base. Sweet and impressionable. 14

Old Fitzgerald Bottled-in-bond bourbons must be distilled at the same distillery in the same distilling season, aged minimum of four years in a government bonded warehouse, and bottled at 100 proof 20

Old Forester 1897 – On the nose, this bourbon initially seems less sweet than the Original Batch, or at least less narrowly concerned with richness. It has a fruit character, with hints of dark fruit, apple, and rye grain 10

Old Forester 1910 – In order to produce 1910, standard Old forester has undergone a second barreling in a lightly toasted, heavily charred barrel The second barrel is charred nearly to the point of incineration 10.5

Old Forester 1920 – In order to produce 1910, standard Old forester has undergone a second barreling in a lightly toasted, heavily charred barrel The second barrel is charred nearly to the point of incineration 11

Old Weller Antique 107- The brand is named after William Larue Weller, a distiller who is credited by some as being the first to use wheat as the secondary grain in straight bourbon as opposed to the more commonly used rye. A full-bodied and oily the bourbon feels rolling around in your mouth. Cinnamon spice grips the taste buds, followed by cherries, dark fruits, raw sugar, and aged oak 20

Sazerac RYE – Fruit flavors comprised of sweet apricots, orange peel, and plums meet more traditional notes of caramel and vanilla. Light barrel char teases in the background, along with a mix of raisin and anise underneath. It has a light body, and at 90 proofs, requires a bit of searching to pull out all the flavors 18

Thomas S Moore – CAB Cask - Apricot, tempered oak, vanilla, light brown sugar, bright and sweet. Black cherry. Plum, warm spice, vanilla, seasoned oak 14

Van Winkle Special Reserve – 12 Year - To the NOSE Apple, apricot, cherry, vanilla, mild oak. Quite expressive with an overall aroma that has some weight to it. On the PALATE Apricot, cherry, mild oak, touch of peach. Surprisingly sweet. FINISH Cherry, oak quite palatable. A

fan of PAPPY's Lot B. It's sweet and fruity and easy to enjoy 125.00

Weller 107 – a wheated bourbon with full bodied flavor and balanced palette 20

Weller Reserve – a sweet nose with a presence of caramel, tasting notes of honey, butterscotch and soft woodlines 16

Woodford Double Oak - matured in separate, charred oak barrels – the second barrel deeply toasted before a light charring – extracts additional soft, sweet oak character 13

Woodford Reserve - rich, chewy, rounded and smooth taste, with complex citrus, cinnamon, and cocoa, finished with a warm satisfying tail 9.5

Yellowstone – A simple and straightforward combination of lightly toasted oak, vanilla, a hint of caramel, and spice immediately greet you. Baking spice, light marshmallow, and a dab of grain in the form of crackers 8

Chivas Regal 12 Year - apples, hazelnut, and butterscotch 10

Dewar's White Label - vanilla fudge, smoke, toffee, heather honey, and oak flavors 8

Glenfiddich 12 Year - fresh fruit, soft oak, and butterscotch flavors with a long, smooth, and mellow finish 12.5

Glenlivet 14 Year Single - brown sugar and baked apple - a rich, sweet single malt 12

J&B Rare Scotch - lots of fruit and a little toffee and malt taste 6

Laphroaig - medicinal, smoky flavor; Laphroaig distillery sits on the south coast of Islay, the first of the three Kildalton distilleries 13

Macallan 12 Year - smooth, with rich dried fruits and sherry, balanced with woodsmoke and spice, with a sweet toffee, dried fruits, lingering wood smoke and spice finish 15
